FYI - Turtle Nesting Season starts May 1st through October 31st, so visiting the beach you will notice the staking of turtle nest and remember that if using a flashlight at the beach at night that your light needs to be red.

I would like to thank you everyone in advance for using the green sheets and pink sheets at the office. The sheets are a great tool for us to use to keep Harbor Lights looking good and safe.

We received a green sheet in April requesting us to look at the video in our Boat yard /Shed area. The person included the time frame and item and when they notice something missing from their boat that is trailered. We checked the video, and we did have an intruder. The area is fenced and locked at night. This did not stop the intruder from finding a way in though. We ask that when storing anything outside that you properly have your items stored away and locked.

The incident was reported with the Venice Police and a report was filed. An affidavit was signed with the Venice Police to patrol the property as a routine at night and arrest trespassers when on the property.

This Month's rule reminder is <u>the</u> speed <u>limit in Harbor Lights is 10</u> m.p.h.

Please keep your speed down the walkers and bikers are still present in Harbor Lights.
